¹⁵ *Be very careful, then, how you live-not as unwise but as wise,*
¹⁶ *making the most of every opportunity, because the days are*
evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the
Lord's will is. ¹⁸ Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to
