### **Matthew 11:28-30**

<sup>28</sup>“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (NIV)

### **Romans 10:9-10**

<sup>9</sup>That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup>For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. (NIV)

### **Matthew 11:2-6**

<sup>2</sup>When John heard in prison what Christ was doing, he sent his disciples <sup>3</sup>to ask him, “Are you the one who was to come, or should we expect someone else?”

<sup>4</sup>Jesus replied, “Go back and report to John what you hear and see: <sup>5</sup>The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor. <sup>6</sup>Blessed is the man who does not fall away on account of me.” (NIV)

### **John 10:10-11**

<sup>10</sup>“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. <sup>11</sup>I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.” (NIV)
